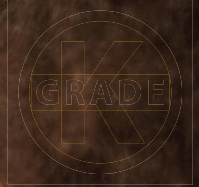

Responsibility

Everyone has responsibilities.
A responsibility is a duty to do
something or not to do something.
Good citizens are responsible.



Responsibility

When you follow the rules you are being responsible.
